God showed us His presence in outdoor worship, worship in a literal “pig pen”, worship in the pouring rain, worship in meeting physical needs, worship on the edge of a volcano and many more places. While numbers are not the most important part of ministry, we were able to count over 900 direct ministry opportunities this past week. God also showed the results of previous ministry by the mission teams from our association in this country. We gave over 100 dresses/shorts to two different ministries there. These dresses were sewn by the **Sewers and Rippers** with fabric and materials donated by many of you at FBSC.
